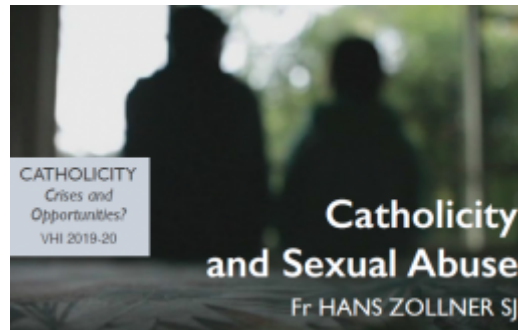
VHI lecture next Friday

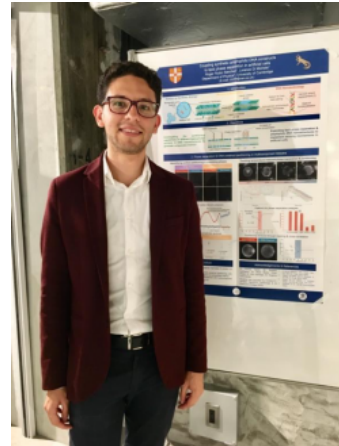
