Over the weekend of 19–20 October, Matt won the Master's 4+ race in a course record time at the Head of the Charles regatta. He also came 14th, with his daughter Honor, in the Parent & Child double scull.

Alumnus Nate Kirk, who rowed in the Cambridge men's blue boat in 2004, was also there, rowing in a Cambridge alumni eight that came sixteenth in its class.

This winter, St Edmund's will refund the cost of a flu vaccination for any students who would like to have one.


If you would like to receive the flu vaccination and be reimbursed by College, here is what you need to do:
