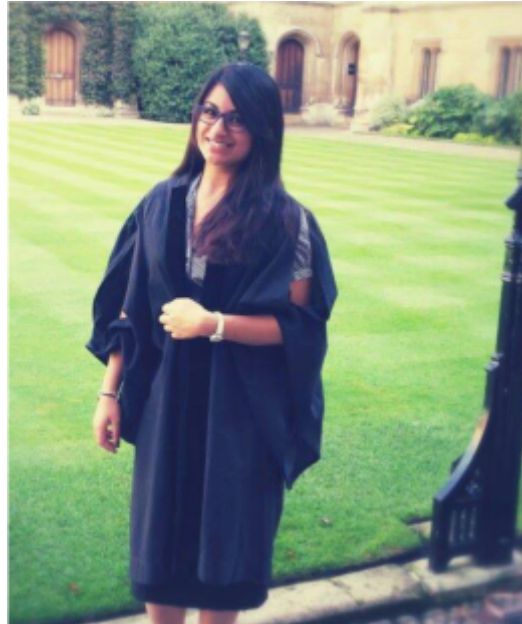


50 years of women – Hina Khalid
