Camvol was established in November 2006. It is a UK charity which organises volunteer placements in India for Cambridge University students.

Camvol is affiliated to the University's Centre of South Asian Studies. Students volunteer during their summer vacation for a period of 8 weeks. Graduates (third and fourth year undergraduates, and graduate students) may go for longer periods. Students would volunteer with environment and development based NGOs mainly in the North of India.

Bye-Fellow awarded Fellowship

Dr Effrossyni Gkrania-Klotsas was awarded a competitive travelling fellowship by the Winston Churchill Trust.

A clinician, trained in both public health and infectious diseases and a member of the department of health committee for the safety of organs and tissues for transplantation (SaBTO), she is developing the first comprehensive transplant infectious diseases programme in the UK.

As part of this project she will spend a sabbatical in Philadelphia, USA and will also host a national meeting in the College in January 2021.



Award for former Visiting Fellow

Congratulations to Professor Pilar Cuder-Dominguez, a former Visiting Fellow at St Edmund's, for recently being awarded the Premio Martín Alonso Pinzón en Valores Constitucionales.

This award is granted by the Government of Spain on Constitution Day to an individual who has shown outstanding support and promotion of constitutional values, in her case gender equality.
