We look forward to seeing & meeting you there!

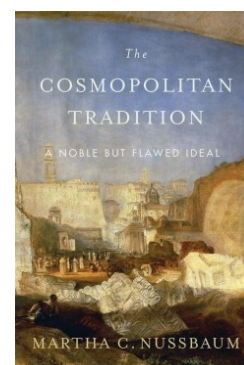


Reading Group: Martha Nussbaum's 'The Cosmopolitan Tradition'

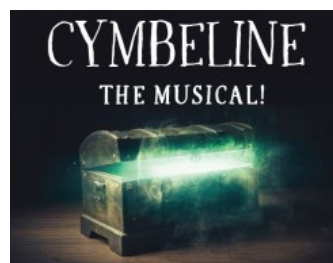


Cymbeline: The Musical
