The book *Anti-Dumping in the Globalized World* is on display in the library and has been signed by the author herself!

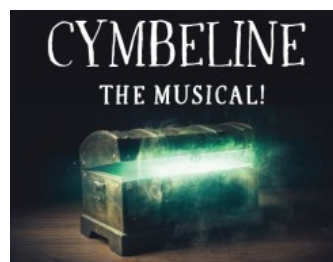


Cymbeline: The Musical

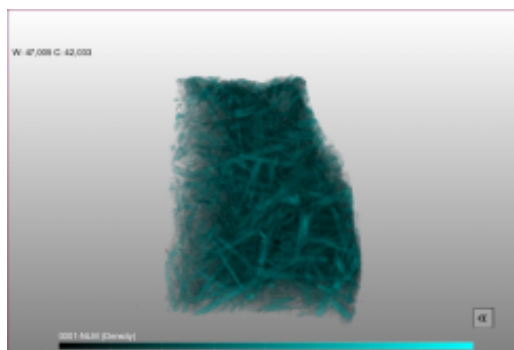
