Notice of Death of Honorary Fellow Peter Smith

Archbishop Peter Smith, an Honorary Fellow of St Edmund's and recently retired Archbishop of Southwark, died in hospital on Friday night after a very short illness.

He was the bishop of East Anglia from 1995–2001, during which time he consecrated the College chapel in October 2000. Even after being translated to the archdiocese of Cardiff and then Southwark, he visited the College frequently and always attended, when he could, the Norfolk Feast.

He was a great supporter of the College and took great pleasure in being an Honorary Fellow.

As a mark of respect, the College flag will fly at half mast until Monday morning.

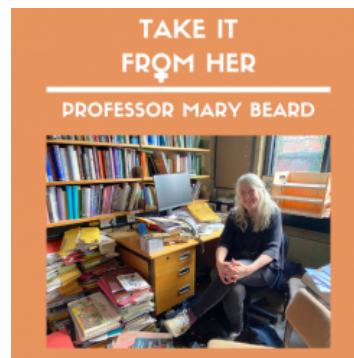
